## Architecture highlights #1

- ▶ PowerEdge R640 2x16C, 256G RAM, 10x SSD, 6x10G SFP)
- ▶ Arista 7280SE-64 (Nikhef)
- ▶ Mikrotik CRS317 (Qupra DC1)
- ▶ Proxmox VE
  - ▶ 2 vm routers running RHEL 9.6 
  - ▶ VPP
  - ▶ Bird 2.13/16
  - ▶ Fork / KEES (thanks Coloclue) -> RPKI / IRR / BGP Communities
  - ▶ Resource isolation (PCI Passthrough / CPU L2 isol+taskset / etc)
- ▶ +/- 160gbits capacity

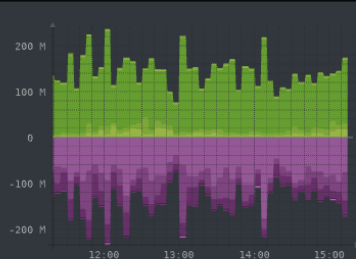
## NETWORK WEATHERMAP NIKHEF



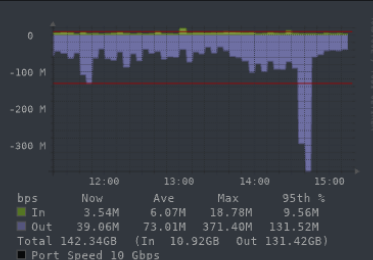
## NIKHEF-1 - Total



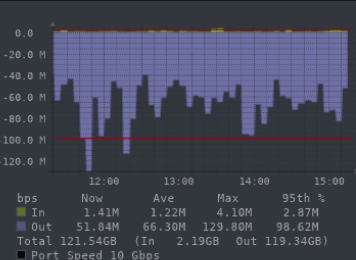
